## **Updated IDPH COVID-19 Guidelines**

If your student does not get a Dr's note with an alternative diagnosis or a negative Covid test their return to school date is:

# STUDENTS WILL STAY HOME/BE SENT HOME IF THEY HAVE:

Been within 6
feet of
someone
diagnosed
with COVID-19
for 15 minutes
or longer
(close contact
or household
contact)



#### ANY of the below symptoms:

- -Fever 100.4 +
- -Diarrhea
- -Vomiting
- -New Cough
- -Fatigue from an unknown cause
- -Shortness of breath / difficulty breathing
- -Body aches from an unknown cause
- New onset of Severe Headache
- -New loss of taste or smell
- -Sore throat + any other symptom
- \*Please note all household contacts (siblings) will be sent home when students are symptomatic\*

# WHEN CAN STUDENTS/SIBLINGS RETURN TO SCHOOL?

Option 1

Healthcare provider note indicating alternative diagnosis of symptomatic student.

Option 2

May return after 10 days as discussed with school nurse

- AND 24 hours fever free
  - AND symptoms have improved.

Option 3

Receive a negative COVID test (NOT Rapid)- AND - documentation turned into the Nurse. Option 4

If COVID positive or symptomatic - must quarantine for 10 days, if exposed to someone with COVID - quarantine 14 days.

### PROTOCOL IF STUDENTS ARE SENT HOME WITH SYMPTOMS

Pick up and sign out student from lobby. Don't forget backpacks, homework and devices. \*Please do not send your student back to school until they have been cleared by Nurse Inlow\*

Students out Covid related, will become E-LEARNERS. Students/
Parents will need to communicate with teachers daily during the E
-Learning period. If students are too ill to participate, RGS must be
notified for students to receive an excused absence. When ELearning guidelines are not followed, students will receive an
UNEXCUSED absence. Please see the RGS Handbook for more
information on the attendance policy.

\*PARENTS/GUARDIANS: PLEASE HAVE CONVERSATIONS WITH YOUR STUDENT ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF HONESTY WITH SYMPTOMS.
WHILE WE CERTAINLY DO NOT WANT TO SEND CHILDREN HOME. IS THEY COMPLAIN OF SYMPTOMS. WE MUST FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES.
