

Blossoms Early Learning Center

Return to In-Person Instruction

Blossoms will begin its hybrid schedule on March 22, 2021. Below you will find important information to assist you in making the transition back to in-person successful.

Schedule

- Your child's teacher will reach out to you (if they have not already) to notify you of which in-person attendance group your child will be a part. We have an A schedule (Mon./Tues.), a B schedule (Thurs./Fri.), and a C schedule (Full remote). All students are remote on Wednesdays.

Arrival

- Students will enter through Door C (Parking lot doors). Please form one line and please social distance.
- Students will enter the building beginning at 8:50am and begin instruction at 9am.
- Parents must complete the health certification upon arrival via the Brightwheel App. Your child's teacher will send you a link via email or text to sign up.
- Students must be checked in via the Brightwheel App (Note: any persons you will allow to drop off/pick up your child must be listed in Brightwheel when you sign up and must have the app downloaded on their mobile device).
- In order to enter the building students must: (1) Wear a masks, (2) Self-certify via the Brightwheel App, and (3) Must not have a temperature over 100.4F.
- Breakfast will be served at school.
- Parking is on Olivia and Cynthia Streets. Only those with a handicap placard or Blossom's placard will be allowed to pull into the parking lot.
- Do not park in front of the school, this area is reserved for buses.

Dismissal

- Students will be picked up at Door C (Parking lot doors); Please form one line, Please social distance.

- Dismissal will begin at 11:30am.
- Students will be given a lunch to take home.
- Parking is on Olivia and Cynthia Streets. Only those with a handicap placard or Blossom's placard will be allowed to pull into the parking lot.
- Do not park in front of the school. This area is reserved for buses.

Uniforms

Students may wear uniforms (polo, khaki/blue/black pants); however, it will not be mandatory for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year.

Bus Riders

Bus riders must be self-certified before they can board the bus. If they are not self-certified before they get on the bus they will not be admitted. Bus riders must be signed in and signed off the bus daily by the parent, guardian, or designee. If the designee is under the age of 18, permission must be requested in writing. If your child arrives at his/her stop and there is no one to pick up the child, the child will be returned to the school and will have to be picked up from school.

Symptoms

Children exhibiting any of the symptoms below should remain at home. For students that have a fever of 100.4F or higher, they should remain at home until the temperature breaks with no medicine for 24 hours.

Fever or chills

Cough

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Fatigue

Muscle or body aches

Headache

New loss of taste or smell

Sore throat

Congestion or runny nose

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea
