Minutes for Finance Committee Meeting, 3/9/21

- 1. Meeting called to order at 4:00 p.m.
- 2. Committee members present: Hannah Kirk, Geralyn Wyke, Angela Stadler, Dr. Paul Schrik
- 3. The committee purpose was reviewed
- 4. Dr. Schrik presented a fund report demonstrating revenue vs. expenditures through the end of February 2021
 - a. In terms of revenue, the district anticipates a large influx of revenue in later spring as it traditionally receives roughly 50% of its allotted property taxes at that time.
 - i. EBF, other state funding, and grant funding are predictably being received.
 - ii. CPPRT is an unknown at this time as the last payment, typically May, may demonstrate itself lower than originally determined by the State of Illinois due to the pandemic.
 - b. In terms of expenditures, the district has experienced much variability due to the pandemic.
 - i. Transportation costs are much lower than budgeted due to remote learning
 - ii. Benefit costs have increased due to more staff utilizing benefits.
 - iii. O & M funding demonstrates increased expenditures in regards to supplies/materials as it relates to the pandemic
- 5. FY21 Budget planning is dependent upon several variables.
 - a. Will Co. levy extension data is expected by the end of March
 - b. The current projections from Springfield demonstrate level funding for FY21
 - The district is working cooperatively with Senator Connor and several school districts to secure CPPRT funding.
 - d. ESSER II funding is projected to provide funding for additional staffing, HVAC renovation, Summer 22 Summer Bridges, and online subscriptions.
 - i. ESSER II grant funding will provide additional revenue, making it possible to update the aging school security system.
 - e. It is anticipated that planning for FY22 budgeting will include increases for transportation, benefits, salaries, and 10-Year Life Safety projects

- 7. Committee members' comments focused on the need to continue to be thorough and adjust as Rockdale SD moves to in-person learning.
