Complete the application and attach the following to it:

1. A cover letter giving an explanation for applying for this scholarship. Be sure to let the committee know which community college or vocational/trade school you will be attending and what you will study. Also share with us any information that will help us get a clear picture of you as a student and your goals.
2. Resume of activities while in high school, including major activities, honors, noteworthy achievement in school, clubs, church and community.
3. Two letters of recommendation focusing on the student's potential for success at the next level of education and sharing reasons why this student would be a good recipient of this scholarship.
 - One letter from the principal, guidance counselor, or a teacher of Dayton High School.
 - One letter from an adult other than relatives.
4. An unofficial transcript of the applicant's high school grades and/or college grades (if applicable).
