Tuesday/Thursday in-person students will play on the following Thursdays: April 1, April 8, and April 15.

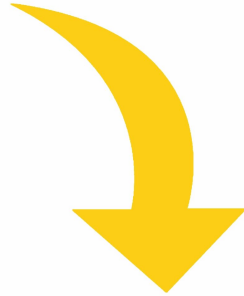
Wednesday/Friday in-person students will play on the following Wednesdays: March 31, April 7, and April 14.

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Notes from the Nurse



COVID-19

Most Common Symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of Breath or difficulty breathing
- Fever
- Chills
- Sore Throat
- New Loss of Taste or Smell

Less Common Symptoms:

- Muscle Pain
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Congestion/Runny Nose
- Other Symptoms of Illness

For any students with ONE MOST COMMON or TWO LESS COMMON symptoms of COVID the following protocol begins.

Students must remain out of school for 10 days from the start of symptoms.
Students may return at any time with a provider note that specifies that they may return.

Negative Covid tests **MAY allow for students to return to school earlier than the 10 days but there are several different tests available and certain situations in which each test may be used. Please check with the school nurse prior to getting COVID tests without provider consultation.**



TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF MAINE



Students must quarantine for 10 days from return or have proof of a negative COVID test.
Please notify the school nurse.
