To Parent/Guardian of an Incoming Freshman:

As we make preparations for your student's enrollment at Marengo Community High School, we want to inform you of our Digital Learning Environment (DLE) 1:1 initiative, which requires all freshmen to purchase a computer by making an \$80 payment each year for the next four years (see [DLE Flyer](#) for more information). Families who qualify for free lunch may choose to receive a loaner computer if they do not wish to purchase one (please sign the Loaner Agreement attached). Students must comply with all policies, handbooks, and guidelines.

Freshmen will be issued their computer at the DLE Distribution on May 26, 2021

- Prior to May 26, **the first Chromebook Purchase Payment of \$80 must be made.** Please log in to your parent portal to make payment (go to our website at www.mchs154.org and click on the Infinite Campus button) or mail us a check made payable to MCHS prior May 26, 2021.
- Prior to May 26, students and at least one parent/guardian are required to review the [2021-2022 DLE Orientation for the Class of 2025](#) and the [Computer Agreement and AUP](#).
- Prior to May 26, please sign the attached [Purchase Agreement](#) and Acceptable Use Policy signature page (or [Loaner Agreement](#)) and return it at the DLE Distribution.
- **May 26 - DLE Distribution:** All students must arrive either between 1-4 pm or 5-8 pm. **If your student is enrolled in summer school, you and your student must come on this date to receive their chromebook.** If you do not attend your student will be dropped from summer school.

In order to help students work ahead, MCHS is offering [Summer School Driver's Education](#). If your student has been recommended to attend Fresh Start Academy this summer, you will be receiving Fresh Start Academy information in the mail later this week. Students recommended for Fresh Start may not enroll in Summer Driver's Ed.

We are very excited about the opportunity the DLE initiative provides our students and staff, in addition to the enhanced parent/school communication opportunities, and look forward to partnering with you to provide your student with a quality education and a positive high school experience.
