Good Afternoon,

We have received confirmation of some changes in the guidelines for travel and those vaccinated as related to COVID. The NYSDOH has approved the guidelines below.

**Travel Guidance:**

As of April 1, 2021 there is NO requirement for quarantine after domestic travel. The NYSDOH has updated its [Travel Guidance](#) accordingly. However, **International travelers are still subject to mandatory quarantines**. In addition, ALL travelers, domestic or international, still must complete the [NYS Traveler Health Form](#).

**COVID Exposure Update:**

- **For Those who are VACCINATED**

Consistent with recent CDC guidance, **asymptomatic individuals who have been fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 do not need to quarantine during the first 3 months after full vaccination, if the following criteria are met:

- o Are fully vaccinated (i.e.,  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine); and
- o Are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series; AND
- o Have remained asymptomatic since last COVID-19 exposure.

- **For Those who have Previously Tested Positive**

Consistent with CDC guidance from February 13, 2021, **asymptomatic individuals who have previously been diagnosed** with laboratory confirmed COVID-19 and have since recovered, are not required to retest and quarantine within 3 months after the date of symptom onset from the initial SARS-CoV-2 infection or date of first positive diagnostic test if asymptomatic during illness.
