Treasurer's Report: Mrs. Tussey shared that the State Auditors have shared that FY20 Audit is almost complete. We had an excellent audit, no management letter. This year has definitely posed its challenges but overall she is happy with the continuous progress that the district has made. Including new software (ReDesign) in June, 2020 along with the electronic requisitioning system (SC View) introduced in December, 2020. I appreciate how the staff has quickly adapted to our new software systems as we have had to quickly adapt to many new electronic processes due to the pandemic.

Superintendent's Report: Mr. Carlier discussed that ODE is saying that the State Testing will proceed as scheduled for this school year. He is happy to know this as our teachers and students have worked diligently to make progress this year and their current MAP scores are revealing this. He shared with them about the ESSER II Funds that our district will be getting to purchase additional supplies, educational technology, mental health and maybe most importantly the Summer Learning Activities that we can provide our students. The Governor has discussed possibly an extended school year for some districts. These funds are also identified as being used for school facilities repairs, air purification and hvac systems and extracurricular.

Jr. High Winter Sports have completed their season and he is very proud of their achievements considering the pandemic along with weather issues. He said that the High School Girls Basketball Coach Toby Sheets was on his last bus ride to an away game at Ripley High School as Toby has informed him of his intentions to retire at the end of this school year. Mr. Carlier said that the HS Graduation is still scheduled for Friday, May 21st and that he and Mr. Wallace are working on a survey to share with the parents of those Senior students on how best to celebrate their 2021 Graduation Ceremony.

Southern Hills Career Tech Update: Mrs. Johnson said they have been working with their students and having similar issues as everyone has with the remote learning environments. She said that the CTC will be introducing a new program for Drivers Education that will hopefully begin in Fall, 2021. They are continuing to make progress with the merging and offering of the Developmental Disability Program.
