Re: Community Update - Vaccinations, Return to full in-person Learning

Greetings Barneveld Families,

I hope this letter finds you well and that the changing season has been refreshing. With spring break upon us, I want to take a moment to thank you for your continued support. The Barneveld community has responded to this pandemic with the utmost resolve and we have accomplished so much together. As vaccinations continue to be administered and we see a steady decrease in the number of infections, we are now in a position to take yet another step closer to our new "normal."

April 6th and 7th:

Our staff members are scheduled to receive their second round of the vaccination on April 6th. Similar to the vaccinations that took place earlier this month, Barneveld will make a temporary pivot to virtual instruction for Tuesday, April 6th, and Wednesday, April 7th. We will return to full in-person learning on Thursday, April 8th. **Students will bring materials home on Friday, March 26th.**

Return to Full In-Person Learning:(elimination of virtual Wednesdays)

With the great progress being made with the vaccine and the decrease in infection rates, we are happy to announce that we will be returning to full in-person learning. Students in ALL grade levels will attend school Monday through Friday beginning the week of April 12th. Furthermore, students in middle and high school will resume normal activities (moving from class to class) and elementary classes will be able to interact with each other during breaks and recess. We will still follow mitigation protocols (face coverings, distancing, hygiene) and continue to adhere to CDC guidelines. This is great news and another step in the right direction.

Families may still opt for virtual instruction.

We are that much closer to resuming a normal life - keep up the great work!
