MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Preston called the hearing to order with a reminder that the mission of the Board and Lawrence County Schools is *Every Child College and Career Ready; A Community Involved and Informed* and led *The Pledge to the United States Flag*.

2. Open Tax Levy Hearing

Chairman Preston declared the hearing open for public comment and read the following published notice.

The Lawrence County Board of Education is holding a public hearing to hear public comments regarding a proposed general fund tax levy of 52.0 cents.

The General Fund tax levied in fiscal year 2014-15 was 52.0 cents on real property and 52.0 cents on personal property and produced revenue of \$3,728,247. The proposed General Fund tax rate of 52.0 cents on real property and 52.0 cents on personal property is expected to produce \$3,968,340 for 2015-16. Of this amount \$997,565 is from new and personal property. The compensating tax rate for 2015-16 is 50.0 cents on real property and 50.0 cents on personal property and is expected to produce \$3,815,711.

The general areas to which revenue of \$141,943 above 2015 revenue is to be allocated are as follows: Cost of collections; \$4,258; technology \$68,842.50; transportation \$68,842.50.

3. Close Tax Levy Hearing

Chairman Preston declared the hearing closed at 6:25 p.m. having no further public comment requested.
