Dear School Community,

Last night, the health department confirmed one more School-Associated Case of COVID-19 in a student or staff person in our school district. We also had one positive case come back from quarantine and so this puts us currently at five (5) positive cases with 141 staff/students who either have tested positive or are out quarantined due to possible exposure, awaiting results on a COVID test, or out to care for small children at home in quarantine.

As a reminder, due to lack of available teaching and support staff, Pine River Area Schools will be remote today, Friday, March 26, with a full return to school scheduled on Monday, April 5.

It is important to remember that we continue to work closely with the Central Michigan District Health Department and District 10 Health Department to identify Close Contacts of all School Associated Cases of COVID-19. Once a case is confirmed by the health department, then contact tracing begins. Anyone identified as a Close Contact will be notified by the health department as a part of the COVID-19 investigation process. School officials are also making phone calls. Please answer the phone if the health department contacts you, as a contact tracer may be trying to reach you with important information.

Thank you for understanding that, due to family and medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the names of the individuals with COVID-19. We will continue to communicate changes and updates with you. With your participation, we believe we can maintain a safe environment while also providing quality education.
