Hybrid Learning beginning March 1st, 2021

- Parents can opt to move from Hybrid to the Remote Plan at any time by notifying the Grade Level VP.
- Parents who have opted for Remote Learning must remain through April 9th, 2021 and will need to submit a letter of request/email to the grade level Vice Principal for a change in learning platforms.

Hybrid Learning Plan

- Blended in-person and remote learning Schedule
- [OBHS Learning Calendar through 6/16](#) where students are separated into 3 cohorts.
 - A Days – Periods 1, 2, 3 & 4/5
 - B Days – Periods 6/7/8, 8/9/10,11 & 12

In-person Days

- Students must bring their personal or school-issued device daily for classroom use.

****Students who choose Remote Learning and students in Cohorts that are not in-person will log into class via Teams for live streamed instruction on beginning at 7:35am.***

Remote Days
