The presiding officer may: prohibit comments that are frivolous, repetitive or harassing; interrupt, warn or terminate a statement when it is too lengthy, personal, abusive, obscene or irrelevant; request that an individual leave if they are disruptive to the meeting; request law enforcement assistance to remove disorderly persons; call a recess or adjournment of the meeting; waive these rules with the approval of the
