The presiding officer may: prohibit comments that are frivolous, repetitive or harassing; interrupt, warn or terminate a statement when it is too lengthy, personal, abusive, obscene or irrelevant; request that an individual leave if they are disruptive to the meeting; request law enforcement assistance to remove disorderly persons; call a recess or adjournment of the meeting; waive these rules with the approval of the Board.

Tape/video recording is allowed as follows: No obstructions are created between the Board and the audience; no interviews are conducted in the meeting room while the Board is in session; No commentary, adjustment of equipment, or positioning of operators is made that would distract Board members or members of the audience while the Board is in session.
