Chisholm School Board names Athletic Director

Chisholm Public Schools has selected Jayden Dobbs as the district's new athletic director. Board of Education members approved his employment during their regular board meeting Wednesday night.

Dobbs is currently the athletic coordinator and a physical education teacher for Waller Middle School in Enid, where he began his career in 2019. Dobbs will begin his duties as CPS athletic director July 1.
