

2020-2021 Spring Activities Fan Attendance Guidelines

Outdoor Activity Guidelines

We are excited to be able to welcome fans to the many activities that will be taking place. Please keep your distance from those participating while in attendance. If you are experiencing any of the following symptoms (fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or greater, persistent cough, shortness of breath, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain of unknown origin, headache without known origin, sore throat without known origin, new loss of taste or smell, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea) please do not attend. If you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days, please do not attend.

According to IDPH, ISBE, and IHSA/IESA guidance, we are allowed to host fans at 20% capacity of our available seating at our outdoor venues. Each activity has a breakdown of the number of fans that each participant can have at home events.

While in attendance at any school events you must wear a mask/face covering (unless there is medical documentation that prevents an individual from wearing a mask, they are under 2 years of age, or they are eating or drinking) and maintain 6 feet of social distance from those not in your immediate family.

High School Boys Soccer

10 family members of the athletes will be allowed to attend home soccer matches once we move into the Stadium, which we anticipate to be the April 6th game. Please wear masks in shared public areas and maintain social distancing. When we attend away contests, please only bring immediate family members.

Home Football Game Guidelines

Ticket Breakdown for Varsity contests:

Senior Football Players - 10 Underclassmen on Roster - 5 Marching Band Members - 5 Cheerleaders - 5

We will create a Student Section Ticket for our <u>High School</u> students only - they will enter at the south gate and not be charged. No Middle School or Elementary students will be allowed in the High School Student Section.

We will create 115 tickets for Opposing Fans and they will be able to distribute them however they want.

Admission prices will be charged for home Varsity contests. Adults are \$5, children and senior citizens are \$3. Olympia students are not charged admission to home contests. A limited concession stand will be offered with prepackaged items and drinks.

Tickets for JV or Freshman home football games will not be issued; 10 fans per rostered player and cheerleader will be allowed.

General Public Tickets: any remaining tickets will be available for purchase on a will call list. Please call the HS Activities Office (309) 379-5911 ext. 9022 after 12 noon on the Wednesday of each **HOME GAME** to reserve your ticket. If leaving a message please leave your name, phone number and quantity of tickets requested (maximum 4).

Underclassmen on Roster - 2

Admission prices will be set by the school that is hosting the events. These are only offered to player's families and there is no general admission.

High School/Middle School Track

We will be able to have up to 560 fans in attendance for all home track meets. Please wear masks in shared public areas and maintain social distancing. We will share traveling guidelines as they are sent to us by the host school.

High School Volleyball

All players will be able to have 6 fans attend for home matches. The fan will simply check in at the table and state who they are in attendance for. Please continue to wear your masks at all times while indoors and sit with your family unit.

When we are on the road - Two spectators for each visiting athlete will be allowed. Visiting parents watching the freshman matches need to arrive at 4:45 PM and must leave after the freshman matches are over. Visiting parents watching the JV matches need to arrive at 5:45 PM and must leave after the JV matches are over. Visiting parents watching the Varsity matches need to arrive at 6:45 PM. Each school will have their own entrance fee, it will vary from school to school.

Middle School Girls Basketball

All players will be able to have 6 fans attend for home matches. The fan will simply check in at the table and state who they are in attendance for. Please continue to wear your masks at all times while indoors and sit with your family unit. There will be no opposing fans. Also we will share guidance when we travel as we receive it from the host school.
