### REPORT TO PARENTS: WARMER WEATHER, HEALTHIER HABITS

As the weather gets warmer, activities move outside. Though less risky than being indoors, we are still fighting the spread of COVID-19. These strategies will help children and families build healthy habits before they head outside this spring.



**Playground Tips:** It can be hard to ensure safety at playgrounds amid COVID-19. If you visit a playground, maintain a distance of at least 6 feet and wash your hands before and after the visit.

**Sports Tips:** Ask the coach to reduce physical closeness between players in practice areas and on the sidelines, and pack extra masks in your child's sports bag in case one gets wet, dirty, or sweaty.

**Handwashing Tips:** Washing your hands is important when playing outside. Wash with soap and water for 20 seconds after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after coughing or sneezing.

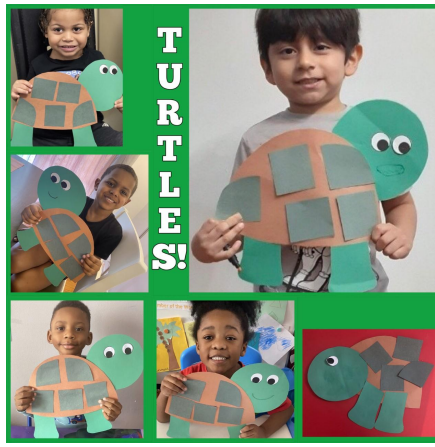
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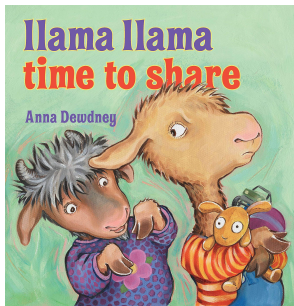
