RE: New School Schedule

With the change in our state which allows for students to socially distance at a minimum of 3' (three feet) we will begin on April 12th with a new schedule. Our hybrid schedule will cease immediately for grades 1-12 as students will return to school. However, due to prior commitments, April 14th will be designated as a Canvas day where students will need to complete work online from home as staff will be engaged in already scheduled activities all day. The schedule for grades used for the week of 4/19 through 4/23 will be followed for the remainder of the year. Please note that all previously scheduled days of no school will continue to be scheduled as no school. These dates include May 28th and May 31st.

The final day of the school year will also remain the same as scheduled. June 17th will be our final day with a release time of 12:10 PM for the Jr/Sr High School and 12:15 PM for the Elementary School.

For those families that decide to remain in a remote learning environment that is still currently allowed. Each building will set the expectations in order to be counted as present during the day. At a minimum, students will need to join remotely with their classmates for each topic at the Elementary School and in each period at the Jr/Sr High School. Teachers will communicate with remote students on how long they need to remain online for each course.

Students must be either fully on-site or fully remote. We are unable to accommodate partial forms of attendance at this time.

Though we are back with a smaller social distancing requirement, there are other rules that must be followed as we bring the year to a close. These include:

- 1. Students are to remain socially distanced as directed by staff.
- 2. Masks must be work at all times and must cover both the mouth and nose.
- 3. Morning screening, either online or on-site, is still required of all students, staff, and visitors.
- 4. Handwashing routines currently in place will remain.
- 5. Cleaning of surfaces and objects as currently being followed will remain.

Students who are unwilling to follow the rules above will be spoken to and a follow-up with parents/guardians will also occur. If compliance does not occur students may be placed in remote learning.

We are excited to have our kids back with us and ready to learn!
