Dear Memorial Parents and Guardians,

The Memorial Staff sends best wishes to you and your family. We have almost reached the end of the 2020-2021 school year. Your support is greatly appreciated as we work together to support your child during this unprecedented time in our world. Before we reach the finish line, we have an important task to complete. The federal government has mandated that all students take the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) and the Illinois Science Assessments (ISA). Below is the assessment schedule noting the dates and times your child is scheduled to be at Memorial to take the IAR and ISA (only 8<sup>th</sup> graders take the ISA) this school year. Please make sure that your child is on time for both drop-off and pick-up. Students will not be allowed to enter for testing once the assessments have begun. **For students to attend testing sessions at Memorial, students must be in compliance with all state regulations for physicals, immunizations, dental, and vision exams. Please contact Nurse Berry at Memorial if you need to check your child's health compliance status. All appropriate safety precautions such as social distancing, wearing a face mask over the nose and mouth, and completing daily temperature checks/health certifications must be followed by students attending testing sessions.**

During testing days, **remote learning students** should enter and exit the school through the designated doors listed below based on the first letter of their last name.

- **A-F** test in the South Multipurpose Room (Enter & Exit School through **Door 17**)
- **G-L** test in the North Multipurpose Room (Enter & Exit School through **Door 19**)
- **M-R** test in the Big (East) Gym (Enter & Exit School through **Door 23**)
- **S-Z** test in the Small (West) Gym (Enter & Exit School through **Door 3**)

All **in-person** learning students will enter the school through their normal door entry listed below.

- **6<sup>th</sup> Graders** will enter through **Door 6** on the westside of the school.
- **Team 7A** students will enter through **Door 10** in the back of the school on the westside.
- **Team 7B** students will enter through **Door 8** on the westside of the building.
- **Team 8A** students will enter through **Door 13** on the eastside of the building.
- **Team 8B** students will enter through **Door 11** in the back of the school on the eastside.

Students are asked to bring their wired headphones from home to connect to laptops and use during the test to hear content.
