What are ESSER Funds?

The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) fund is a federal program, approved by the Department of Education as part of a larger COVID-19 aid plan.

- Keeping schools open
- Investing in infrastructure
- Emergency financial assistance for a variety of necessary projects to school districts in the country

Allowable Uses of Funds

- Repairing and improving school facilities to reduce risk of virus transmission and exposure to environmental health hazards.
- Improving indoor air quality
- Summer learning programs
- Continuation of employment and hiring staff
- Expansion of facilities

- > Total ESSER Allocation \$1,948,967.00
 - 20% must be set aside for learning loss \$389,794.00
- State Reserve Funds (additional funds) \$285,127.00
 - Learning loss\$198,167.00
 - Summer Enrichment \$43,480.00
 - After school \$43,480.00
