After starting his own family, he continued to nurture his agriculture roots by raising goats, pigs, and cattle. One of his favorite things to do was travel with his girls to livestock shows across the state and was often more excited than they were when they won. Calvin was involved in multiple capacities with the Lee County Junior Livestock Show and enjoyed fundraising to support the local agricultural youth through the Manheim Youth Supporters.
