Cell Phone / Pager

In accordance with the Menominee Junior/Senior High School Approved Code of Conduct, cell phones are prohibited from use, or having them ON during CLASS. The exceptions to this rule are that students may use their cell phones if their teacher has a sign outside of their door turned to the green side indicating phones may be used for the day's lesson. In addition, they can be used before and after school and during the lunch period in the cafeteria and adjoining lobby area. Failure to follow the cell phone policy will result in the following disciplinary actions:

1 st Offense	Phone is returned to student at the end of the day.
2 nd Offense	Phone suspension on school grounds for 30 days; the phone will be returned to the parent.
3 rd Offense	Phone suspension or the remainder of the school year; the phone will be returned to the parent.
4 th Offense	Indefinite suspension from cell phone privileges at school and the student is referred to the principal.

Teachers may indicate via the green card outside of their classroom door if students may use cell phones for a particular class period to leverage teaching and learning options. Any student caught using their cell phones to cheat, cyberbully, or to post inappropriate messages during the school day will be suspended three (3) days out of school in addition to the above consequences. If severe enough and with administrative discretion, the student may be referred to the suspension for expulsion.

Note: Any student failing to turn over his/her cell phone to a requesting administrator or staff member will be referred for immediate disciplinary action for insubordination (3 day suspension) in addition to the action required by the cell phone policy.
