What are we doing at the IT district level?

Removed access to Google Hangouts/Chat

Students can only send/receive emails from staff members in the @eatontown.org domain

Removed the ability to delete chrome history

GoGuardian filtering (chromebooks and windows devices)

Students can only sign in to their school device with @eatontown.org account (ensuring the above happens)

GlobalProtect filtering (windows devices only)

Monitor/help student in real time

Open tabs for students

Close tabs for students

Screenshot student screens if needed

Privately chat with students

Make an announcement to all students

Use the 'click link' feature to access open google doc/slides/sheets for immediate help

What can you do at home?

Check web-browser history

Contact your Wireless Provider to see if they offer parental filtering

‘Google’ the websites your children are using to see if they are age-appropriate

Limit screen time - ‘lock up’ the devices at a certain time

Sit with your child and ask them to explain the game/site they are on (not all websites are bad!)

If social media is allowed make sure they know how to:

- block accounts, report abuse, set privacy settings
