## What are we doing at the IT district level?

- Removed access to Google Hangouts/Chat
- Students can only send/receive emails from staff members in the @eatontown.org domain
- Removed the ability to delete chrome history
- GoGuardian filtering (chromebooks and windows devices)
- Students can only sign in to their school device with @eatontown.org account (ensuring the above happens)
- GlobalProtect filtering (windows devices only)

Monitor/help student in real time

Open tabs for students

Close tabs for students

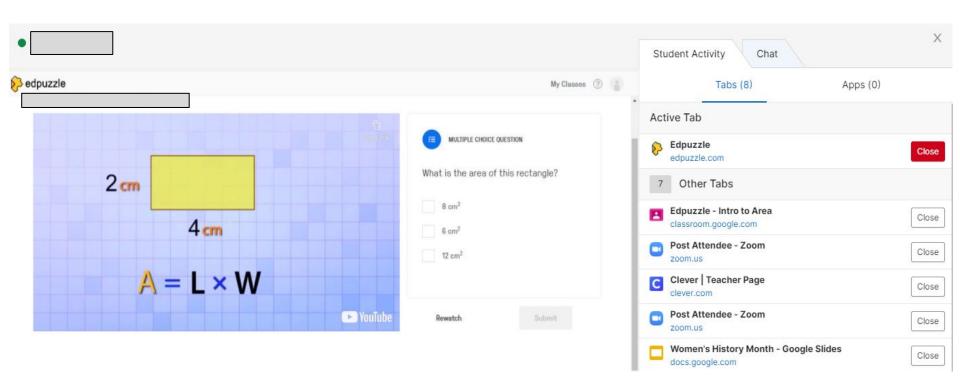
Screenshot student screens if needed

Privately chat with students

Make an announcement to all students

### What can you do at home?

Check web-browser history

Contact your Wireless Provider to see if they offer parental filtering

'Google' the websites your children are using to see if they are age-appropriate

Limit screen time - 'lock up' the devices at a certain time

Sit with your child and ask them to explain the game/site they are on (not all websites are bad!)

If social media is allowed make sure they know how to:

block accounts, report abuse, set privacy settings
