

# 2021 WCHS SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION

## Summer school priority registration due May 7th, 2021

Dates: June 7th- June 25th

Times: 7:30 am- 12:30 pm for PE; Math and/or English in-person, & Online (2 credit recovery courses)

### Attendance Requirement

- Some students will be required to attend summer school in person from 7:30 am- 12:30 pm. Those students include the following:
  - Any PE student
  - Any current freshmen completing math or English 9 credit recovery
  - Any student taking two credit recovery courses
- Students taking one credit recovery course or taking credit advancement (health, government, economics) may work virtually from home. Teachers will be available for assistance 7:30 am - 12:30 pm.

### To register

- For all classes, families must complete an online registration form. The link can be found at <https://tinyurl.com/phumb4pa> or the QR code below. If summer school fills to capacity, students will be placed on a waitlist.



### In-Person Orientation Meeting

- Students attending in person summer school will report at 7:30 am on June 7th to Door 1 at WCHS.
- Students taking online courses will have an in-person orientation at 8:30 am on June 7th to make sure that all students know the expectations and have access to the online platform, APEX. Please report to Door 1 at WCHS. This includes students on the waitlist. Students that do not attend this meeting will lose their summer school spot to a person on the waitlist.

### General Information

- The fee for summer PE is \$65. Online classes are offered at no charge.
- Students may sign up for two online courses.
- Initial summer school slots will be given based on a first come, first served basis.

- Summer school classes are for incoming WCHS 9<sup>th</sup> graders (class of 2025) and current WCHS students. If space is available after the initial enrollment date, students not currently enrolled at WCHS who reside in the school district may be eligible to attend classes.
- Incoming 9th graders (Class of 2025) may only sign up for the following courses: PE, health, biology for grade improvement, algebra for grade improvement, geometry for grade improvement.
- Students taking PE and an online class will attend PE for the full session and complete the online class from home.
- Students that hope to play NCAA Division I or Division II college athletics should discuss with their counselor if APEX online courses are appropriate.
- If the class needed is not offered through WCHS's summer school program, please see your counselor for alternate options through Indiana Online Academy.
- After the registration form is turned in, counselors will review to ensure appropriate class/classes are selected.

### Summer PE

1. Summer PE requires a \$65 fee. Families may pay prior to the first day of summer school by dropping off payments to Jayne Trivett in the high school main office. Payments can also be turned in on the first day of class. Payment is cash or checks made out to WCHS. Payment is due by the first day of summer school.
2. PE will be held at the WCHS main campus.
3. Students should bring a swimsuit and regular P.E. clothes for the 1<sup>st</sup> day of class.
4. Students are expected to attend daily. **No more than 3 absences are allowed.**
5. Class of 2025 athletes are strongly encouraged to take PE1 during the fall semester of grade 9 and earn PE2 credit through a sports waiver. Athletes should not take summer PE.
