

Career Readiness Diploma

Students in 11th Grade (Junior) are eligible to pursue a Career Readiness Diploma. Grade level placement is determined by the students age and their academic career (RITS- Record Integration Tracking System). This academic program is designed for the traditional student and the overaged and under-credited student.

Units of Credit Needed

A total of 22 credits. A credit is defined as the amount of credit given for the successful completion of a course. Successful completion means that the student obtained a passing grade for the course.
