To that end, the Committee has partnered with Connected Nation Texas and their “Connected Community” program to assess the present state of broadband in Tyler County and establish a broadband planning process and plan to address our current and future broadband needs.

To perform an assessment of Tyler County current broadband environment, the Committee will be conducting surveys of local residents, businesses and other organizations across the counties. Responses to these surveys will help us better understand the existing resources and capabilities we now have to support our access, adoption, and use of broadband technology in our homes and businesses. After a structured evaluation of this assessment, we’ll then develop appropriate action plans and projects to improve our broadband environment most effectively.
