The complete site acreage is 21.6. The total square foot of all buildings are 141,168 to be serviced.

Cutter Morning Star School District will need 3 day porters, 1 lawn care person with 1 additional "seasonal lawn care person", and 5 evening cleaning personnel. Cleaning Company is responsible for all cleaning materials, supplies and equipment needed for all duties. The cleaning company will also be responsible to purchase each employee a key card at \$10.00 per key card for each employee. Replacement cards will be \$25.00 if employee breaks or misplaces their current card. Each employee will need to be in company attire with a name badge to be easily identified at all times. It will be the responsibility of the cleaning service to have current background checks on all employees. When employees are on campus providing these services they are not to interact with students or staff at any time.

This contract will begin July 1, 2021 thru June 30, 2022 with a 30-day cancellation of contract.

Daily

- Empty wastebaskets and replace liners as needed
- Spot clean all interior windows
- Clean and sanitize counters and sinks
- Dust mop, with chemically treated dust mop, all hard surface floors
- Spot vacuum all carpet
- Vacuum walk-off mats
- Clean chalkboards/trays
- Spot clean desktops for large debris

Weekly

- Dust horizontal surfaces to hand height (70")
- Clean baseboards as needed
- Damp clean window ledges
- Sweep edges and corners to remove debris
- Wet mop hard surface floors
- Detail vacuum all carpet
- Remove fingerprints from doors, frames, light switches, kick plated, handles, and railings
- Clean insides of all exterior windows (providing furniture is not in the way)
- Spot clean carpets using encapsulation or dry compound

Monthly

- High dust above height horizontal surfaces, including shelves, ceiling, moldings, pipes, ducts, heating outlets, etc.

- Wash and sanitize exterior of containers
- Remove spots, marks, stains, and splashes from wall areas
- Spot clean metal partitions
- Sweep floors
- Damp mop floors with germicidal disinfectant
- Re-supply common area restroom dispensers during the day
- Re-supply personal area restroom dispensers during the night cleaning
- Remove fingerprints from doors, frames, light switches, kick plates, plush plates, handles, railings, etc.

Weekly

- Remove dust and cobwebs from ceiling areas
- Wash and sanitize metal partitions

- Low dust all horizontal surfaces to hand height
- Sweep baseboards

Monthly

• High dust above hand height all horizontal surfaces including shelves and moldings

 - o Full strip 6 to 7 coats of finish as a minimum

Daily

- Empty trash cans
- Replace all plastic can liners

- Clean well around trash cans
- Dust mop/sweep floors
- Damp mop floors
- Vacuum walk off mats
- Clean water fountains
- Spray buff composition floors (two times weekly)

Weekly

- Remove fingerprints from doors, frames, light switches, kick plates, handles and railings.
- Low dust horizontal surfaces to hand height
- Damp clean baseboards and window ledges

Monthly

High dust above hand height horizontal surfaces, including shelves, moldings, pipes, ducts, heating outlets, etc.

Annually (Christmas)

- Scrub and refinish composition floors
- Clean windows

Annually (summer)

- Strip and refinish composition floors (with at least 5 coats of wax)
- Clean windows

Outside Building

Daily

- Empty trash cans
- Replace all plastic can liners
- Sweep entrance walkway
- Pick up trash around entrance, parking lot and grounds
- Remove snow from walkway entrances, as required

Grounds

Turf Care

Grass cut once every 5 working days

- Aeration as required, but not less than 2 times per year
- Reseeding or sodding when bare spots are present
- Weed control practiced when weeds present a visible problem or when weeds represent 5% of the turf surface

Fertilizer

- Adequate fertilizer level to ensure that all plant materials are healthy and growing vigorously
- Amounts depend on species, length of growing season, soils, and rainfall
- Trees, shrubs, and flowers should receive fertilizer levels to optimum growth.

Irrigation

- Sprinkler irrigated—electric automatic sprinklers commonly use.
- Some manual sprinklers could be considered adequate under plentiful rainfall circumstances and with adequate staffing
- Frequency of use follows rainfall, temperature, season length, and demands of plant material

Litter Control

- Minimum of once per year, five days per week.
- Off-site movement of trash depends on the size of the container
- High use may dictate daily

Pruning

- Usually done at least once per season unless species planted dictate more frequent attention.
- Sculpted hedges or high growth species may dictate a more frequent requirement than most trees and shrubs in natural growth plantings

Disease and Insect Control

- Usually done when disease or insects are in Officting noticeable damage, and reducing vigor of plant material, or could be considered a bother to the public
- Some preventive measures may be used, such as systemic chemical treatments

Floral Plantings

- Care cycle at least once a week, but watering may be more frequent
- Health and vigor dictate the cycle of fertilization and disease control
- Beds are to be kept weed free
