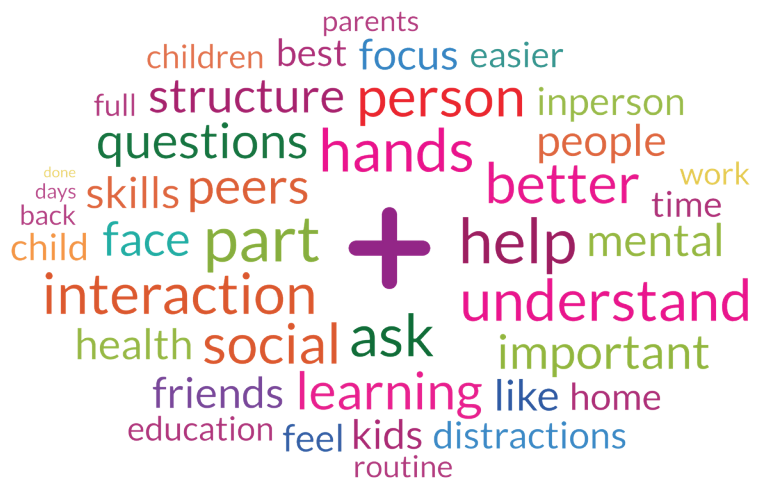

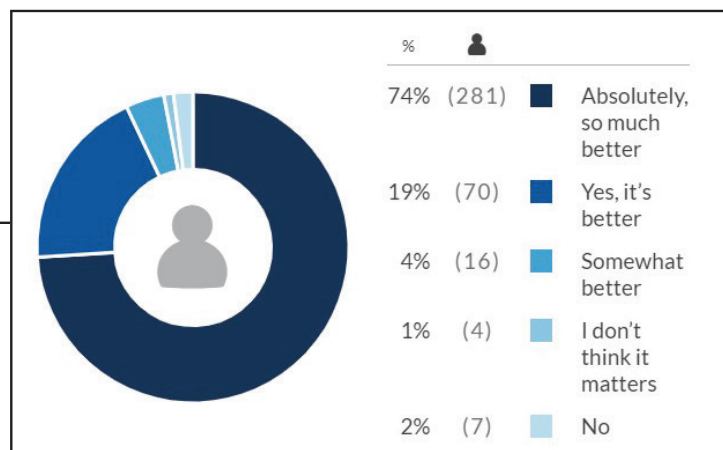
### What is the best part of returning to in-person learning?

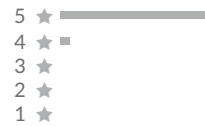

## Q1 What is the best part of returning to in-person learning?

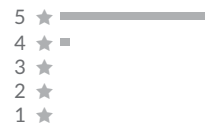
**Access to peers has been positive for my student.** My student missed human interaction outside of his immediate family.

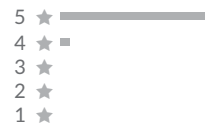
**Learning in person is important for a lot of learning styles.** Students are able to better understand what they are being taught.

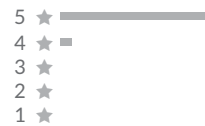
**Better interaction with teachers in person. Promotes better learning**

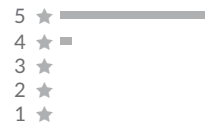

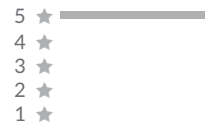

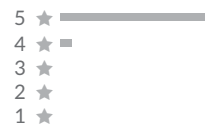
