



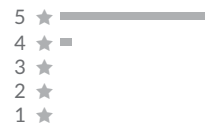

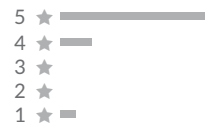
Being able to work at our own pace. They visit family throughout the year and don't have to miss any school when doing KVA

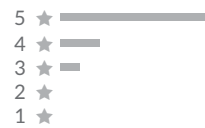
One on one meetings with teacher My son has one on one meetings every week and the teacher is focus only on him

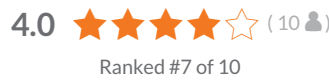


Being able to do work at our own pace and time. It allows me to still work full time and teach my child on my off time.

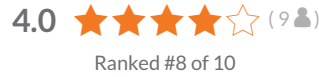

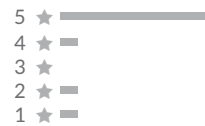
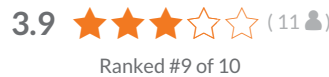
There is more flexibility when it comes to my child's school day. Having more flexibility allows my child to stop and ask questions about a subject without having to be rushed through it.
