

# Title I FAMILY/PARENT INVOLVEMENT <sup>1</sup>

The Slate Valley Unified Union School District<sup>2</sup> maintains programs, activities, and procedures for the involvement of parents/guardians of students receiving services, or enrolled in programs, under Title I Part A of Elementary and Secondary Education Act. These programs, activities and procedures are described in school level compacts. Family/Parent involvement activities conducted annually to implement these requirements shall occur at Slate Valley schools.

## **Definition**

*Parent:* Includes a legal guardian or other person standing in loco parentis (such as a grandparent or stepparent with whom the child lives, or a person who is legally responsible for the child's welfare).

## **School Level Parental Involvement Compact**

Each building principal or his or her designee shall develop a School-Level Family/Parental Involvement Compact in accord with Title I, Part A requirements. The School-Level Family/Parental Involvement Compact shall include: (1) a process for continually involving families/parents in its development and implementation, (2) how families/parents, the entire school staff and students share the responsibility for improved academic achievement, (3) the means by which the school and families/parents build and develop a partnership to help students achieve the State's standards, and (4) other provisions as required by law. Each principal or designee shall ensure that the compact is distributed to families/parents of students receiving services, or enrolled in programs under Title I, Part A.
