This message is a final reminder about what is needed from all seniors for the Senior Section of the 2021 Yearbook and how you can order Dedication Ads for Graduating Seniors to be published in the yearbook.

**Please check with your seniors to learn what they may be missing and encourage them to submit senior photos and senior quotes if they have yet to do so.**

- Every graduating senior will be showcased in the Senior Section, including 3 items:
  - Photo from any time Before High School
  - Senior Photo
  - Senior Quote (provided through a Google Survey all seniors have access to)

**All items above must be emailed to me no later than April 19.**

**Regarding Senior Photos**, if we do not receive one by **April 19**, we will include the photo that Lifetouch took of the student in August. If I receive in an email a senior photo and it is before we send the book off to publication in late May, we will replace the Lifetouch photo with the photo I receive. If a student already has an appointment with a photographer set for late April or early May and may just be a little late, then please email me now so I know to expect it.

*Please know that senior photos do not need to be taken by professional photographers; one may submit any quality photo as long as the primary focus of the photo is the student and the photo is in good taste, adding to the collective positive character of the Class of 2021.*

- Yearbooks can be purchased at [yearbookforever.com](http://yearbookforever.com) for \$60 throughout May. **Sales close June 1.** There is no guarantee extra yearbooks will be available to purchase in August.
- If you would like to purchase a **1/8 page Dedication Ad** for your graduating senior, you can do so at [yearbookforever.com](http://yearbookforever.com) (just as you order a yearbook) **by April 19**. For \$30, you can write a personalized message and submit an additional photo of the graduate.
