Fourth Quarter Changes

New CDC guidance along with building level data, supports us in making some adjustments for the fourth quarter. We will continue to be diligent when it comes to mask-wearing, hand washing, sanitation, and contact tracing. I am confident that these changes can be done safely and will help meet the social-emotional needs of our students. Please see the changes below:

Band

We will be changing band for the 4th quarter to start playing music in person. For these changes, all band students will need:

- Instrument (personal or renting)
- Pencil
- Yellow Band book (Mr. Schroeder have extras if needed)
- Personal Mask

Students will be given an **instrument mask** which they will wear during band. This specially made mask has an opening for their mouthpiece. Drummers will use their own personal mask. **Bell covers** will also be used for all wind instruments. Social distancing and proper ventilation will also be implemented. It is an expectation that all students will be wearing a mask and using bell covers at all times during band class.

Lunch and Recess

Students in grades 1-8 will be eating in the lunchroom. Students will be eating by cohort:

4K and 5K will continue to eat in their classrooms. 1st and 2nd **11:30-11:50** 3rd-5th **12-12:20** 6th-8th **12:30-12:50**

We have purchased two air purifiers for the lunchroom. When weather permits doors will be opened and students may have the option to eat outside.

Students have been able to use the playground equipment and gaga pit with masks on. This will continue for the fourth quarter.

Woods at Home Families- THANK YOU

Woods at Home students will be transitioning to a more independent study learning model 4th quarter. Shortly after Spring Break, over 93% of students will be learning in-person. In order to sustain the dual learning model with the majority of students in the classrooms, we will no longer be Livestreaming during core lessons. We will work with individual students and families through this transition. Our WAH families will receive a schedule today that includes dedicated time each week to meet with their homeroom teachers, counselor, and other support staff each week. Students who need intervention or other supports will continue to receive those. We continue to as families to be diligent around temperature screening and isolation of students with symptoms or who have has close contact. If your student must quarantine or isolate please contact the school or your child's teacher to make arrangements for work completion while they are out. You will be provided with the WAH schedule and all materials and technology needed so that your student does not fall behind.

A huge thank you to all of our families who have spent time virtual this year and to the teachers for all of your hard work running two learning models. We worked through something brand new together and I cannot express how honored I feel to have been a part of the journey with you.



Temperature Checks

We will continue to have staff self-monitor by asking them to check their temperature prior to leaving home each day or upon arrival at school.

Based on new CDC guidance we will no longer be doing daily temperature checks for students.

- **CDC does not currently recommend schools conduct symptom screening** for all students in grades K-12 on a routine (e.g., daily) basis.
- Parents, caregivers, or guardians ("caregivers") should be strongly encouraged to monitor their children for symptoms of infectious illness every day through home-based symptom screening.
- Students who are sick should not attend school in-person.

This will help us to be able to make sure all staff is notified of the absence and that a plan is in place for making up work. Thank you!
