Dear Parent/Guardian:

Metuchen High School 11th Grade students will take the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) SCIENCE, which is a state mandated, computer based assessment, from 8:15 – 10:30 am on May 17,18 2022. This assessment is aligned to New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS) for grade 11 Science. All 11th grade students will take the 11th grade Science exam.

The assessment consists of two ninety minute sections. Students will take one section per day on both May 17th and 18th. After the testing has been completed each day, all MHS students will return to their regularly scheduled bell schedule for the remainder of the school day.

Be sure that your child arrives to school no later than 8:15 am on testing days, after having had a good night's sleep and having eaten a healthy breakfast. Additionally, **all chromebooks MUST be fully charged each morning and students must bring a pair of wired (plug-in) headphones to use during the test.** Wireless earbuds or Bluetooth connected headphones are not permitted as per test security guidelines. Additionally, students should bring a wired mouse *IF* they would like a mouse for their chromebook.

Please understand that testing regulations prohibit unauthorized electronic devices into the testing room, therefore, no personal electronic devices of any kind will be permitted in the testing rooms at any time. Unauthorized devices include, but are not limited to, cell phones, apple watches or smart watches, fitness trackers, iPads, personal laptops, and other electronic devices. Students must use their district provided chromebook for test administration.
