April vacation is upon us and I've heard many excited children talking about vacation plans. I want to make sure that our school community understands the importance of following the CDC guidelines for travel. If you are planning to travel to any state other than New Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, Massachusetts, or Rhode Island, please use this link to access the guidance from the Maine Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for your travel plans upon leaving and returning to the state of Maine. <https://www.maine.gov/.../airborne/coronavirus/travel.shtml>

It is mandated that all out-of-state travelers coming into Maine, as well as Maine residents returning to Maine, complete a 10-day quarantine upon arrival. Travelers should monitor for signs and symptoms for an additional 4 days. This means:

- You need to arrive with enough food for 10 days or arrange to have food delivered to you. You cannot go out to grocery stores.
- Stay at home. You cannot go out to public places.
- Avoid contact with others, especially those who are at high risk of severe COVID-19 illness.


The State will allow adults who have a negative COVID-19 antigen or molecular (PCR, NAAT, or isothermal) test collected no more than 72 hours before arriving in Maine to forgo the 10-day quarantine upon arrival in Maine.

Individuals who have completed a COVID-19 vaccination series and are 14 days beyond the completion of the series are exempt from the testing and the 10-day quarantine requirement above, regardless of their state of origin.

At the Boothbay Region Elementary School, we ask that anyone who travels to a non-exempt state to receive a PCR test at the Respiratory Care Clinic (207-563-4353) 5-7 days after returning to Maine. <https://www.maine.gov/.../testing/damariscotta-lincolnhealth>. You must quarantine until you have received a negative test result. Once you have been notified of the test result, please have it faxed to the BRES office at 633.7130 For more information, please reach out to Nurse Kate, 633.9814 or kschwehm@aos98schools.org, for guidance.

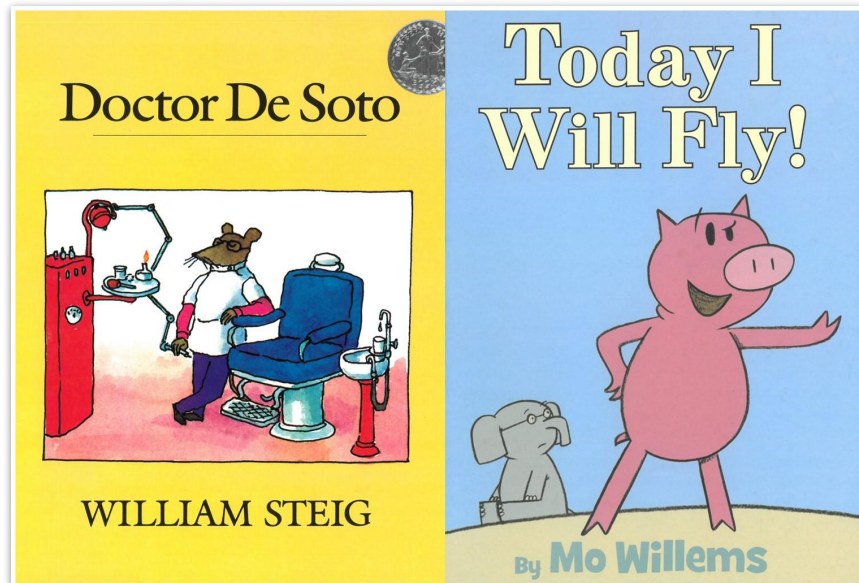
