Update on COVID-19 Communication Cont..

- Governor issues on 4/9/21 the following Summary:
 - While not a new order, the governor today strongly encouraged districts to move to remote learning for high school students for the next two weeks.
 - It is also strongly recommended that youth sports (both school-sponsored and non-school sponsored teams) suspend in-person activities, like games and practices, for the next two weeks.
 - Additionally, the state is offering **56 pop-up sites located throughout Michigan as part of a special program to increase access to testing for those returning from Spring Break**. For more information on additional test sites, visit michigan.gov/coronavirustest.

Currently - 1.64% of students are positive, while 5.59% are quarantined.

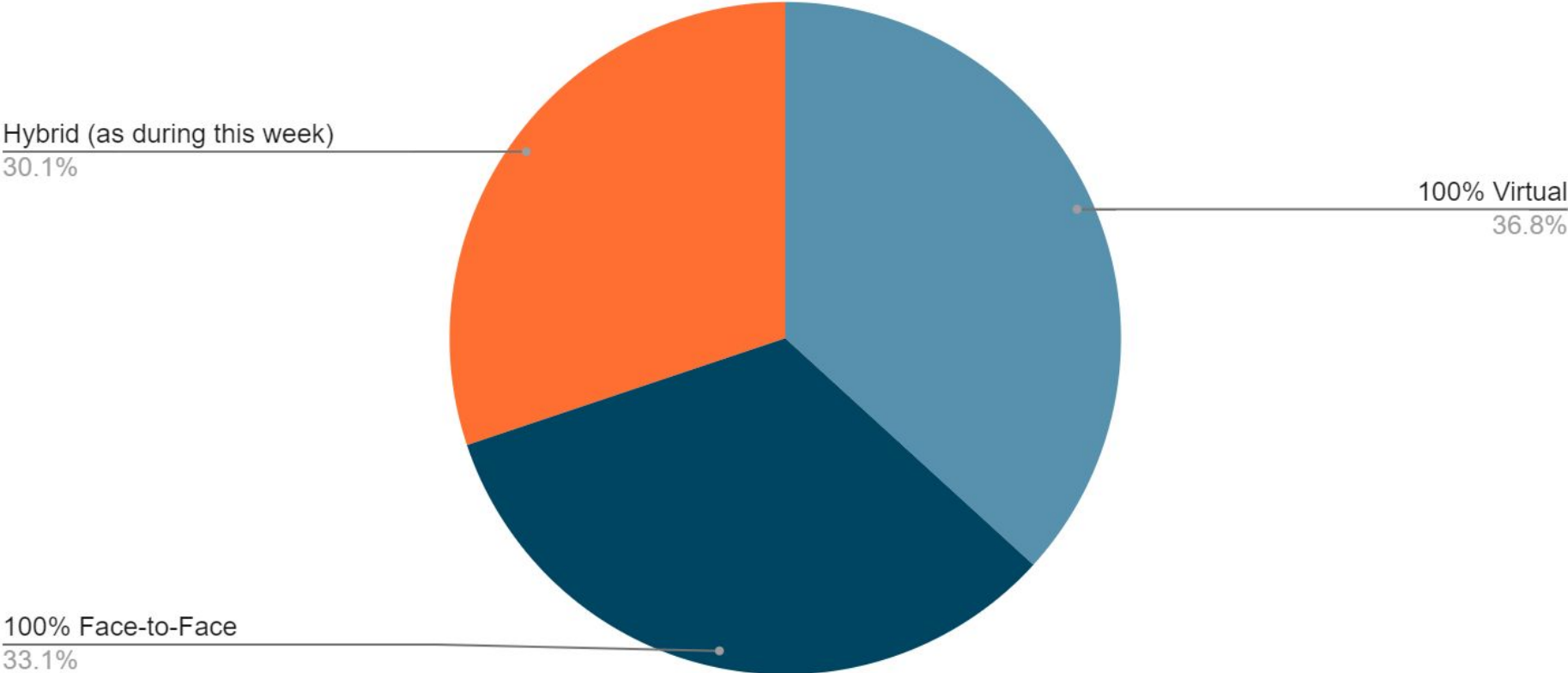

- Only juniors would report for WorkKeys testing
- Students with approved accommodations will finish the SAT testing
- Students would leave once testing is completed
- 9th, 10th, & 12th graders would be remote and continue to work on their Edgenuity classes

Thursday- April 15, 2021

- Only freshmen would report for PSAT testing
- Students with approved accommodations will complete the WorkKeys testing
- Students would leave once testing is completed
- 10th, 11th, & 12th graders would be remote and continue to work on their Edgenuity classes

Friday-April 16, 2021

- Only sophomores would report for PSAT testing
- Students would leave once testing is completed
- 9th, 11th, & 12th graders would be remote and continue to work on their Edgenuity classes

April 19th - April 23rd

- Students would have the opportunity to come in and work on their Edgenuity classes. Due to our program set up, we would have no more than 15 students face to face in a given day. Our classroom allows the students to social distance from each other.

Pioneer High School Virtual Plan

- Students will continue to complete their work on Edgenuity/Off-Site.



Athletic/Extra Curricular Proposal Secondary

- All extra-curricular activities including athletics would continue as normal EXCEPT in a 100% remote learning situation. In this case, only outdoor activities would be permitted with no indoor access allowed.
- Athletics would continue weekly testing as required by MDHHS.
