- Virtual students are to be dropped off by parent / guardian starting at 7:30 a.m. each day.
- If students are in need of transportation be sure to alert your child's teacher when she calls for you alert.
- If students have a broken chromebook or no chromebook please alert your child's teacher when she calls
- Breakfast is served 7:30 a.m. to 8 a.m. each day.
- We will serve lunch to students before departure each day.
- Students are to be picked up at 1:30, no later than 2:00 p.m. on th 22nd. Students are to be picked up at 3:00 p.m. on the 23rd. We will celebrate virtual students prior to departure on April 23rd.
- If your student needs transportation, confirm with your child's teacher when he / she reaches out to you
- Virtual students reporting for testing do not have to wear uniforms.
- Students will be socially distanced and we will adhere to all safety guidelines.
