



Established in 2018, this scholarship fund was created in memory of Hadlee Anne Holik of Wall. Hadlee passed away at sixteen months old fighting a rare form of brain cancer, called AT/RT. She courageously battled the cancer with chemotherapy, radiation, and trial drugs, all to no avail. Even at her young age, Hadlee possessed a strong and resilient spirit despite the harsh effects from the treatments.

In establishing this scholarship, Hadlee's family wishes to recognize the great generosity and support given to us by the Wall community, as well as, honor the life of Hadlee Holik.

APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

1. The student must be a graduating senior from Wall High School, Wall, TX.
2. The student must have a GPA of 90.0 or higher.
3. The student must demonstrate plans to attend an institution of higher learning, which may be a 2-year or a 4-year college. Students pursuing a degree in the field of medicine will be given special consideration.
4. The student must have shown outstanding citizenship traits and have been involved in student service activities and extra-curricular activities.
5. The student must exhibit a strong work ethic.
6. When all other factors are considered equal, consideration will be given to students who have demonstrated a financial need.

THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recipient(s) shall be selected by the Wall High School Faculty, in agreement with the family of Hadlee Holik.
2. The amount of the award will be determined each year depending on the number of recipients.
3. The scholarship will be presented to the chosen recipient(s) at the Wall High School Graduation Ceremony or Awards Ceremony.
4. The student must show proof of enrollment in a college.
