

# **Galesburg CUSD #205 COVID-19 Protocols**

## **Screening Procedures**

All students, staff, and visitors must self-certify that they do not meet any of the IDPH/CDC Covid-19 exclusion criteria before boarding any district vehicles or being present on school district property.

## Face Coverings (Mask)/Hand Washing

- All individuals on CUSD #205 property or being transported in a district vehicle must wear IDPH/CDC recommended face coverings.
- Individuals who have a medical condition in which they need to wear a face shield in lieu of a face mask must obtain documentation from their physician.
- Frequent hand hygiene/disinfecting per IDPH/CDC guidance is required.

#### **Exclusion Criteria**

### ❖ Symptoms of COVID-19 include

- ➤ Fever (100.4°F and above) or chills
- New cough
- > Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- > Fatigue from unknown cause
- Muscle or body aches from unknown cause

- > New onset of moderate to severe headache
- > New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Vomiting or diarrhea

#### Who needs to be excluded?

- ➤ Anyone who has a positive COVID test
- Anyone awaiting COVID test results
- > Anyone that was a close contact of a **confirmed positive** case of COVID
  - What is a close contact? If you have been in within 6 feet of a positive case for 15 minutes or longer during the contagious period, with or without a face covering
- > Persons who are exhibiting COVID-like symptoms and their household contacts
- Persons who have met IDPH COVID travel exclusion criteria

#### How to Return to School from Quarantine

- Student/Staff with a Positive Test: You may return after isolating for 10 days from the start of symptoms or from the date of testing AND improvement of symptoms and free of fever/ vomiting/diarrhea for 24 hours. Confirmation from the Knox County Health Department must be provided to the Health Services Coordinator.
- Student/Staff who are considered a close contact to a positive: You will need to quarantine for 14 days after the last/most recent contact with the positive case. Additionally, monitor symptoms and if symptoms develop and/or a positive test is obtained, please refer to "Student/Staff Member with a Positive Test". Confirmation from the Knox County Health Department must be provided to the Health Services Coordinator.
- Vaccinated Staff and Students may not have to quarantine if they:
  - Are fully vaccinated (i.e.,  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of on dose of a single dose vaccine)
  - Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID exposure
- Persons who have a lab confirmed positive COVID-19 test within the last 90 days may not have to be quarantined if they are asymptomatic.
- **Student/Staff excluded due to symptoms:** may return to school with:
  - > A negative COVID test OR obtain a note from a provider with alternate diagnosis; AND
  - Free of fever/vomiting/diarrhea and improvement of symptoms for 24 hours
