COMMITTEES AND DELEGATES

The White Mountains Regional School Board may have the following standing committees as deemed necessary:

- 1. Educational Programming/Curriculum
- 2. Facilities
- 3. Finance/Budget
- 4. Personnel
- 5. Policy
- 6. Safety
- 7. Health & Wellness
- 8. Strategic Planning

The Chair shall appoint members to the standing committees at the first meeting following the School Board organizational meeting. Such appointments shall be confirmed by the Board.

Committees will meet as needed on problems pertaining to said committees and will make recommendations for action by the full board. The Chair of each committee will make sure that agendas are made and posted and that the Chair will take minutes and have available to the public no later than 144 hours after the meeting (see RSA 91-A:4 I).

The Board shall have sole power to establish or dissolve any of its standing committees and shall reserve the right to exercise this power at any time during the year.

Standing committees are advisory in nature. The ultimate authority to make decisions will continue to reside in the powers and duties of the Board as imposed by law.
