



# Huntington Local Schools Learning Recovery & Extended Learning Plan



COVID-19 has impacted our community, children and schools in an unprecedented way. On February 9, 2021, Governor DeWine asked schools and districts to work with their communities and educational stakeholders to help students whose learning has been affected by the pandemic. Huntington Local Schools has developed a plan that combines small group instruction, intervention, summer programming and long-term monitoring to help our students gain the academic and social-emotional growth necessary to be successful moving forward.

## Academic Need Determination

HLSD will identify students most impacted academically by the pandemic through classroom and district assessment data, MAPS data and teacher input. Attendance records, online student participation and instructional time will be reviewed to ensure those students that received minimal face to face instruction are identified and supported through our extended learning plan. Vertical alignment meetings will be held to identify standards and skills that students need to know and what has been missed due to the pandemic and closure of school. Students that are candidates for retention will be identified and team meetings inclusive of parents will be held to monitor learning and determine need for retention.

## Social Emotional Need Determination

Huntington utilizes two licensed school counselors to provide individual and group counseling and classroom character education lessons. Case management and behavioral health services are also provided through contracted providers, such as Integrated Services of Appalachia Ohio. Teacher-based-Teams discuss students that are showing signs of social-emotional needs.
