The Oregon Administrator Scholars Program seeks to address financial barriers that pose challenges for ethnically and linguistically diverse candidates pursuing their administrative license and are on the journey towards becoming a school administrator in Oregon. The Oregon Administrator Scholar's Program (OASP) is offering scholarships up to a maximum of \$1,000 for racially or linguistically diverse administrator candidates accepted and enrolled in an approved administrator program.
