ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM

The Advanced Placement (AP) program has been developed for the purpose of providing opportunities for academically capable students to pursue college-level course work and potentially receive college credits.

AP courses will be offered to students when it is considered to be educationally sound and financially feasible. The offering of an AP course is contingent upon a minimum enrollment of six students, unless otherwise approved by the Board, and the availability of a staff member qualified to teach the course.

Students who register for AP courses are required to take the AP examination. In hardship cases, the examination fee may be reduced at the discretion of the Building Principal.
