End-of-Year Plan for Masks & Quarantine

Pursuant to Magnolia Board of Directors updated Plan for Learning through the remainder of the 2020-21 school year.

The Secretary of Health shall issue a public health directive requiring every person in Arkansas to wear a face covering over the mouth and nose:

- in all indoor environments where:
 - they are exposed to non-household members and
 - distancing of six (6) feet or more cannot be assured and

Exemptions for Persons:

- younger than 10 years of age
- with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering
- performing job duties where a six feet distance is not achievable, but a mask is inhibitory to the ability to safely and effectively perform the job duty
- participating in athletic activities, p.e., or recess
- consuming food or drink
- receiving services that require access to the face for security, surveillance, or other purposes may temporarily remove a face covering while receiving those services
- giving a speech or performance for broadcast or to an audience; however, those persons shall safely distance from nearby individuals

Quarantine guidelines:

Any individuals that meet one or more of the criteria below **do not** have to quarantine:

- those who are within 90 days of having tested positive,
- those who are considered fully vaccinated (post 2 weeks of vaccination for a single dose vaccine and post 2 weeks of the second dose for a two-dose vaccine)
- those in K-12 schools where a mask mandate policy is in place and both the positive case and the close contact were properly wearing masks.
