

The American Institute of Architects - Long Island Chapter sponsors an annual Scholarship Program to promote student involvement in the architectural profession.

The scholarship awards available are in the amounts of \$3,000, \$2,000 and \$1,000.

Requirements:

- An electronic copy of your portfolio in pdf format, a minimum of 5 student projects as examples of work shall be included. Submissions of collaborative projects where the applicant's role is not clear are discouraged. Work presented may include architectural, engineering or art projects.
- A short statement completing the following: "What is your vision on the role of Architecture in society"
- Candidates must be a High School Student who will be attending an architectural school; or a 4th/5th year Collegue Student studying Architecture; as well as a resident of Nassau or Suffolk County.

Jurors will be Board Members of the AIA Long Island Chapter. The number of awards shall be determined by the Jurors. The decision of the Jurors and Board Members is final. Scholarships will be presented at our Annual Golf Outing at the North Hills Country Club, Manhasset, New York. Winners will be notified prior to the Golf Outing.

Submissions are due on or before 5:00pm, Friday, May 21, 2021.
