Submit two current letters of recommendation, one from a school faculty member, and one from a community member, that specifically recommend you as a good candidate for a scholarship. These letters may accompany your application or may be submitted separately to the high school counseling office (attn: Mr. Cannon). Scholarship Committee members are NOT allowed to write letters of recommendation. (Refer to Application Instruction # 6)
