Hi Parents and Guardians,

The Missoula Children's Theatre is here next week to produce the *Jack and the Beanstalk* play with the help from your kids. They changed it from the *Snow Queen*, which we reported earlier, to *Jack and the Beanstalk*. The play is for students that are interested, they do not need to participate if they do not want to. It is just a fun opportunity to work together and express themselves!

Before they get started, the theatre group wants to get an idea of how many kids are interested in participating. So **please check in with your child and have them tell their teacher this week if they want to audition for the play.** The teachers will have a sign up sheet in their classrooms to keep track.

Auditions for students that signup are on Monday, April 19th at 4:00 pm in the Multi-purpose room (cafeteria). Once a student is given a part, they will be given a schedule of rehearsals applying to their part in the play.

Rehearsals will comprise of two sessions per night and start on Tuesday at 4:15-6:15 pm and 6:15-8:15 pm and go through Thursday. Depending on their role, each student may or may not need to be at all rehearsal times. Masks will be required during rehearsals and the play. This year there will be no makeup to put on for the play.

The play will have two showings on Friday, April 23, in the school auditorium at 3:00 pm and 5:30 pm.

Along with the play, the theatre group offers three workshops during the regular school day. The workshops offer more in depth learning and experiences and include Acting, Improv, and Behind the Scenes. Based on their grade and their interests, kids will be assigned a workshop at school with some workshops allowing space to add more kids from other grades.
