

CYBER SERVICES PROGRAM

CASD provides a cyber schooling option to any student who resides in the Clearfield Area School District. CSP students are full-time CASD students who may enjoy the academic, co-curricular, athletic and social opportunities available to all district students. CSP students may enroll in pure cyber services classes, blended course of study, credit recovery courses, or are required to participate in the program as an alternative education program.

Students enrolled in CSP enjoy several advantages from other cyber programs that include the opportunity to earn a Clearfield Area School District diploma and participate in graduation ceremonies, opportunity to attend the Clearfield County Career and Technology Center, individualized programming (part-time or full-time enrollments), opportunity to participate in the activities offered in the district, and state assessments (PSSA and Keystone) offered at the home school all while maintaining regular contact with school personnel. CSP provides a laptop, printer, printer cartridges, printer paper, reimbursement of internet services, and all appropriate course materials at no cost to the parent/guardian.
