I am writing to let everyone know that we are starting to see a noticeable increase in the number of positive student COVID cases in the school district. The increase is very concerning and we cannot let our guard down! Fifteen students have tested positive for COVID since March 26, 2021 and over one-hundred students are currently in quarantine due to being deemed close contacts to a positive case.
