A staff member will meet you to receive your child and walk them to the line.


ABC Car Parking Lot

Attendance Requirements

Students are required to attend school at least 85% of the time, this is the same whether we are in person or virtual. Virtual attendance is when you and your child(ren) participate in the virtual activities sent by your child's teacher through Ready Rosie or Teaching Strategies Family. The Ready Rosie ap sends vou videos and links to books to read to your child. We ask that you send communication to your child's teacher to say how the activities are going, or even if you

did a different activity using items you have at home. If you have any questions you can message your child's teacher through the ap. This is also how the teachers collect growth and development information about your child to enter into our tracking system TS Gold.
